



## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

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The following outlines the Terms and Conditions associated enrolling your child in Little Wolfies. Please read these Terms and Conditions carefully. These Terms and Conditions are subject to change.

As the parent/guardian please note this form also acts as a Parent's Consent Form and Media Release Form.

### **PART 1: PARENTAL CONSENT TO PARTICIPATE IN LITTLE WOLFIES**

As parent/guardian of the enrolled child, I warrant that I am the parent/guardian of said child, and I give permission for this child, to partake in the Little Wolfies Program.

I acknowledge that I must be present at all times (or have a suitable replacement – e.g. Childcare Worker) whilst Little Wolfies sessions are taking place.

### **PART 2: ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF LITTLE WOLFIES TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

#### **A: ROLE OF THE PARENT/GUARDIAN**

The parent/guardian must make sure they have registered their child.

The Childcare Centre will normally be responsible for the safety of the child whilst the child is attending the Childcare. This still applies when Little Wolfies sessions are running at a Childcare Centre. The parent acknowledges and agrees to this.

#### **B: INSURANCE**

To be insured, a child must be registered.

All parents are encouraged to seek medical advice for their children before playing to ensure they are fit and capable of participating in a Little Wolfies Program.

If your child suffers from an illness or disability of some sort, you must provide a formal Medical Certificate clearing your child as fit for play. The onus to obtain and then provide this Certificate rests with the parent/guardian. All registered children agree to be covered by the Marsh Advantage Insurance company, please email [littlewolfies@wolfmanwilliams.com](mailto:littlewolfies@wolfmanwilliams.com) if you would like to see the insurance policy.

For a child (parent/guardian) to make an insurance claim, they must report the incident to the coach on the day/night of the injury. A failure to do so voids a child's right to claim through the insurance policy.

#### **C: DISCLAIMER & ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS**

In consideration of Little Wolfies allowing my child, once they are a registered child, to participate in the Little Wolfies Program and events run by Little Wolfies, I agree to release Little Wolfies from all liability for any claim or demand or damage or personal injury or illness sustained by my child (a) arising from or in respect of my participation in any game or other activity (Little Wolfie's related or otherwise) arranged by

or on behalf of Little Wolfies, whether or not the injury is caused by Little Wolfies or any other person; and (b) whether or not the damage, personal injury or illness arises from the negligence or breach of any statutory duty of Little Wolfies or any other individual.

I acknowledge that: (a) in the conduct of the Little Wolfies Program or other activity, some physical contact will occur between my child and other individuals involved in the Program; and (b) I consent to that contact being made; and (c) I will not hold Little Wolfies or any other Little Wolfies Representative responsible for any injury or illness my child may suffer in respect of that contact.

### **PART 3: MEDIA RELEASE FORM – I CONSENT TO MY CHILD’S IMAGE/PHOTO BEING USED**

Little Wolfies and/or its agents respectfully request to be able to make use of pictures/videos/images of your child whether that be on the website, Facebook or other related mediums. Images may be used in both administrative material (reports, updates etc) or promotional material (e.g. flyers, online adverts etc). Little Wolfies will not remunerate the child/parent or make any payments for the use of these images – royalties or otherwise.

Little Wolfies will retain copyright in all images and videos produce in the course of running Little Wolfies related competitions or activity.

### **PART 4: MEDICAL DETAILS PERTAINING TO ILLNESS/CONDITION**

I acknowledge it is my responsibility to bring to the attention of Little Wolfies, any illness or condition my child has or may have.

I accept that as the parent/guardian that I need to be present during the entire program and take full responsibility for health and wellbeing of my child during each session OR have an appropriate proxy instead such as a childcare worker.

I accept that I am responsible for the administration of any medication, treatment to my child during the program or have an appropriate Proxy instead to administer such treatment such as a Childcare worker.

I accept that it is my responsibility to inform Little Wolfies of the type and nature of the illness my child may or does have BUT acknowledge that conveying this information does not make Little Wolfies responsible in any way shape or form for looking after my child.

The child is the parent/guardian’s responsibility who may themselves outsource this responsibility to the Childcare Centre. We will use the information provided to us in relation to any illness or condition as a guide to helping facilitate any treatment a child may need but Little Wolfies takes no responsibility for administering any treatment, medicines or providing medical advice. The child must be under the supervision of the parent/guardian at all times.

### **PART 5: PAYMENTS POLICY**

In the case where parents are charged for the Little Wolfies sessions, either in multipasses or full term packages, payments are made by direct transfer to Little Wolfies bank account. The figure will be outlined in an email to the parent/guardian of the child after the registration form has been completed and handed in/emailed to Little Wolfies. With a multipass, a session will only be deducted from the child’s pass when the child attends a Little Wolfies session. In regards to a full term payment, the child will be charged no matter whether they attend on the allocated day or not. In the event the coach is unable to attend, a credit will be given to children participated under a full term payment. The parent will be notified of this via email.

Payments must be made in full and before your child is allowed to attend a Little Wolfies session.

Note: Credits cannot be exchanged for refunds. Little Wolfies will keep an accurate log of credits.

Wet Weather: If a session is missed due to wet weather, the 30 minutes missed will be made up over the following two weeks, or otherwise at the earliest convenience to the children and the centre.

Balls/Apparel/Equipment: If you pay for any of these items in addition to your nominated sessions purchase, no refunds will be afforded unless goods are faulty.

Refunds: In regards to the full term selection, no refunds will not be issued unless Little Wolfies is at fault of not providing the allocated sessions within the agreed time slot. For multi pass options, no refund will be issued period.
